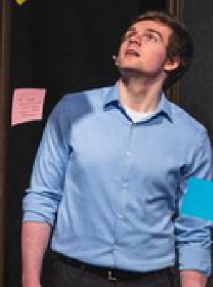
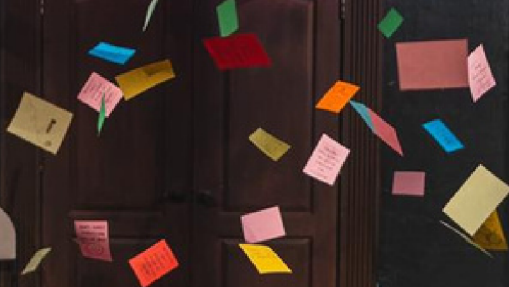
KORDA'S AUDIENCES CONNECTION & COMMUNITY

Our diverse slate of shows for 2025 includes a popular mystery-crime caper based on the work of bestselling crime novelist Agatha Christie; a famous Oscar Wilde comedy; an acclaimed ghost story brought to life on stage; a summer camp program; plus a holiday panto. Added into the mix are four Broadway musicals including a comedy musical satirizing the legal system, capitalism, and more; a musical-within-a-musical journey of an original show to the bright lights of Broadway; a horror-comedy-musical loosely inspired by the 1956 horror film *Invasion of the Body Snatchers*; and a jukebox musical blending a 1950s sci-fi film with Shakespeare's *The Tempest* in a show that will be staged at the nearby Walkerville Centre for the Creative Arts, in partnership with the school's theatre program, and with Stratford Off the Wall to design and create the exciting production.

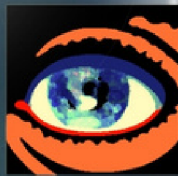

2025 | SOMETHING FOR EVERYONE

URINETOWN is a hilarious musical set in a Gotham-like city, where a terrible water shortage caused by a 20-year drought has led to a government-enforced ban on private toilets. The citizens must use public amenities, regulated by a single malevolent company that profits by charging admission for one of humanity's most basic needs. Amid the people, a hero decides that he has had enough and plans a revolution to lead them all to freedom!

MURDER ON THE ORIENT EXPRESS takes us aboard Agatha Christie's luxurious train, where an American tycoon lies dead in his compartment, stabbed eight times, his door locked from the inside. Isolated and with a killer in their midst, the passengers rely on detective Hercule Poirot to identify the murderer - before they can strike again.

RETURN TO THE FORBIDDEN PLANET is a high-energy jukebox musical that's packed with rock 'n' roll classics. Audiences blast off on a routine flight and crash into the planet D'Illiria, where a sci-fi version of Shakespeare's *The Tempest* – set to rock 'n' roll golden oldies – unfolds with glee!

[TITLE OF SHOW] is a musical about two guys writing about musical about two guys writing a musical. Two struggling writers with nothing to lose, and with the help of their two talented friends, set out to create a new musical to take Broadway by storm.

THE GUY WHO DIDN'T LIKE MUSICALS takes us to Hatchetfield, where everything is normal... until people begin singing... and dancing... and a musical pandemic sweeps the entire city. It's up to Paul - an average guy who doesn't like musicals - and his friends to stop this musical apocalypse and fight for humanity's future.

The **EXTENSION-KORDA SUMMER SESSIONS** program will include summer camps, musical performances, productions, cabaret nights and special events. Over the years this innovative program has become a popular experience for youth artists to work alongside mentors and peers to learn the ins and outs of operating, programming and performing in a true community theatre setting.

THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING EARNEST brings us to Oscar Wilde's London in the 1890s, where two young gentlemen use the same pseudonym ("Ernest") on the sly, which is fine until they both fall in love with women using that name, which leads to a comedy of mistaken identities.

THE WOMAN IN BLACK is an unusual spine tingler in which a lawyer hires an actor to tutor him in recounting to family and friends a story that has long troubled him concerning events that transpired when he attended the funeral of an elderly recluse. There he caught sight of the Woman in Black, the mere mention of whom terrifies the locals, for she is a spectre who haunts the neighbourhood where her illegitimate child was accidentally killed, and anyone who is unfortunate enough to see her will suffer a terrible tragedy!

KORDA'S ANNUAL HOLIDAY PANTO has become a beloved December family tradition in Windsor-Essex. Each year offers an original holiday panto that gives a fresh take on a familiar tale. Expect silliness for the kids, naughty jokes for the grown-ups, bad drag, great music, magic, mayhem, and loads of audience participation for everyone in a goofy, delightful, all-ages musical production to close out the season.
